

The Global Event in Catalonia by LIFE GreenAdapt Project "From Waste to Resource: Bridging Circular Economy and Ecosystem-Based Approaches for Climate-Resilient Infrastructure" will be held on 27 May 2025 at the Casa Batlló Gaudí Barcelona. Organized by the GreenAdapt Project, funded by LIFE Programme of the European Union, this important event will bring together a diverse group of invited stakeholders and pre-selected projects for networking and synergies that will help enrich the methodology and infrastructures developed by the project.

LIFE GREEN ADAPT aims to enhance the resilience of EU waste infrastructures to climate change impacts. The project will demonstrate the potential of blue-green infrastructures (BGI) and ecosystem-based approaches to manage flash flooding and runoff from heavy rainfall, as well as to prevent fires and explosions resulting from droughts and extreme heatwaves. The initiative integrates five complementary technologies, designed to collectively strengthen infrastructure resilience. Together, they form a systematic strategy for adapting waste infrastructures to climate change, while also contributing to pollution reduction through landfill leachate bioremediation, boosting local biodiversity via the creation of constructed wetlands, cutting carbon emissions through the deployment of BGI solutions, and promoting the transition to a circular economy.

The project anticipates a range of significant outcomes and impacts. Notably, **bio-technosoils-produced from landfill waste**-will be used to stabilize and rehabilitate degraded soils, enhancing their structure and regulating nutrient availability to improve overall soil quality. **New innovative treatment wetlands (TW)** will be engineered to treat polluted landfill leachate and runoff, achieving up to a 95% reduction in heavy metals and a 99% reduction in ammonium and BOD₅ compounds. Finally, an industrial-scale demonstration site will validate the effectiveness of the BGI and ecosystem-based approaches, providing concrete evidence of their performance and scalability.

Global Event Structure

The Global Event will focus on four main topics:

Topic 1: Transforming Waste Systems for Resilience – **Key focus:** Rethinking landfills, solid waste management, and industrial by-products through circular economy principles to reduce climate vulnerability.

Topic 2: The Waste–Water–Ecosystem Nexus. NbS for Infrastructure Design – Key focus: Embedding natural processes into the built environment to buffer against floods, heat, drought. Synergies between wastewater reuse, organic waste valorization, and ecosystem restoration. Co-benefits. Maintenance, governance, and scaling.

Topic 3: Inclusive Governance and Community Engagement – Key focus: Ensuring that circular and nature-based strategies are participatory, equitable, and rooted in local knowledge.

Topic 4: Financing and Policy Innovation for Regenerative Infrastructure – Key focus: Unlocking enabling environments for circular and nature-based infrastructure transitions. Green finance, blended finance, climate funds. Circular economy policies linked to adaptation strategies. Procurement, standards, and incentives.
